Parking Tickets Payment Plans

The New York City Department of Finance is excited to announce the

availability of online payment plans for parking tickets that have not been paid and are in default – known as judgment debt. Those with \$350 and more in parking ticket judgment debt can now enter an online payment plan with DOF to make payments over time instead of paying all at once, which can prevent enforcement actions such as having a vehicle booted or towed.

Understanding that financial hardships or other challenges can arise, DOF is thrilled to provide New Yorkers with our new online payment plan system for a more convenient way to pay off parking ticket debt. Entering into an online payment plan with DOF and making payments in installments can prevent future enforcement actions, so don't delay and enter into an online payment plan today.
